2026 – 2027 5th & 6th Grade Supply List

Binder:

- **Binder:** 3-ring, zipper style, preferably with a zipper pocket for pencils/pens on the front (Suggested brand: MEAD 5 Star)
- **Supplies to be kept in binder:**
 - 1 pack of 7 subject tab dividers with pockets for binder (label dividers as Bible, English, Math, Reading, Science, History, Latin)
 - 2 large packs of college ruled paper (place one throughout binder behind each tab and store one in locker for refills later in the year)
 - 1 pack of 50 standard weight sheet protectors (place a few in each section of their binder)
 - 1 pencil bag to fit on binder rings
 (*inside pencil bag should be these items from general supplies listed below: several pencils, a red pen, a highlighter, 2 Expo markers, several cap erasers, scissors, 2 glue sticks, and the small handheld pencil sharpener)

General Supplies (these are stored in locker):

- **Backpack** with compartment for iPad (NO rolling backpacks!)
- **School Box** This small school box will be kept in the locker to house the following general supplies needed throughout the year:
 - 1 large pack (30 count #2 pencils (mechanical or wood))
 - 1 small handheld pencil sharpener (for sharpening colored pencils)
 - 2 packs of cap erasers
 - 4 glue sticks
 - scissors
 - 1 pack of Twistable crayons
 - 1 pack of red pens
 - 1 pack of highlighters
 - 1 pack EXPO dry erase markers
 - 1 pack of colored pencils
- **Locker decorations** are limited to foldable or hanging locker shelves and magnetic pencil holders. Mirrors, white boards, pictures, stickers, magnets, wallpaper, carpet, hanging lights, etc. are not allowed. These distractions cause students to be late to class and disrupt 4th grade classrooms.
